recovered wood fiber, and is an ECC™ (Eco-Certified Composite) certified product being the optimal choice for additional LEED points and other low-emitting specified projects

RESPONSIBLE PRACTICES

ARAUCO employs responsible best practices in the manufacture of every product, relying on wood grown in certified, sustainably managed plantation forests and /or post-industrial reclaimed fiber as raw materials.

Arauco branded lumber, plywood, millwork and pulp sold in North America comes from wood grown in the company’s own certified, sustainably managed plantation forests. The wood used in Arauco’s North American composite panel facilities is predominantly recovered fiber from post-industrial and/or post-consumer sources.

The use of recovered fiber diminishes harvest pressure, extends the forest resources, and diverts significant volumes of material from waste streams.

ARAUCO is committed to making full and responsible use of available forest resources, and does not use wood from native forests or genetically modified trees in any of its products. All of ARAUCO’s mills are certified as compliant with FSC Chain-of-Custody standards, verifying that they can trace the wood fiber used in production back to the source of origin.



ARAUCO’s North American composite panel mills are certified to the Composite Panel Association’s (CPA) Eco-Certified Composite™ (ECC) Standard, indicating the mills’ implementation of a number of performance criteria. All ARAUCO composite panels sold in North America are manufactured in compliance with the California Air Resources Board’s “CARB-2” standard for formaldehyde emissions. ARAUCO mills also have attained ISO-9001, ISO-14001, and/or OSHAS 18001 certification.

ARAUCO’S RESPONSIBLE PRACTICES



- All wood fiber sourced from certified, sustainably managed plantation forests or reclaimed from post-industrial sources.
- No use of wood from native forests or genetically modified trees in any ARAUCO product.
- Verified legal origin.
- USDA Lacey Act compliant (imported products).
- California CARB-2 compliant (composite panels).
- Mills powered with carbon neutral, biomass-generated green power or clean-burning natural gas.
